

## **2025 Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation Scholarship Guidelines**

This year, the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation<sup>®</sup> is offerings the following scholarships:

## 1. Prodigy Scholarship

## Warner Music Latina Scholarship

- The Prodigy Scholarship will be awarded to **one (1)** exceptional student interested in Latin music, that has severe financial limitations and has been **previously admitted to Berklee College of Music** in Boston to start in the **2025 Fall semester**.
- An award with an amount of up to US \$50,000 annually, on behalf of the student, will be sent for four consecutive years of full-time study (16 credits minimum) towards a bachelor's degree, and for a total amount of up to US \$200,000. Additionally, the student will receive wrap around services from the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation valued at \$50,000 during their studies.
- In order to qualify for continued assistance, the student must honor and maintain standards of excellence that will be assessed **every semester** of the four years of study.
- The selected student must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of **3.50** each semester.
- Awarded students must comply with the <u>Student Scholarship Terms and Conditions</u> <u>Contract</u> of the Foundation.
- The Warner Music Latina Scholarship cannot be used for online classes.
- All applicants must complete the Warner Music Latina Scholarship application on the LGCF website, before the deadline.

## 2. Gifted Tuition Scholarships

#### Frost School of Music Scholarship Gil Family Foundation Scholarship

- The Gifted Tuition Scholarships will support **several** talented music students (1 per scholarship type), interested in Latin music who require financial assistance to start their musical education at college or university degree level in **2025 Fall semester**.
- Students applying to the Frost School of Music Scholarship must be admitted to Frost School of Music at the University of Miami for the Fall 2025 semester.
- Those who demonstrate the most talent, perseverance and determination will be selected from a competitive pool of international applicants by the Scholarships Committee.

- The award will cover four consecutive years of **full-time study** towards a bachelor's degree in the music institution at college level that the recipient was admitted in.
- Each scholarship recipient will receive an award for up to US \$25,000 annually, for four years of full-time study, payable by semester, for tuition costs only, towards a Bachelor's Degree and for a total amount of up to US \$100,000. Additionally, the student will receive wrap around services from the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation valued at \$20,000 during their studies.
- In order to qualify for continued assistance, each recipient must honor and maintain standards of excellence that will be assessed **every semester** of the four years of study.
- The students selected to receive the Gifted Tuition Scholarship must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of **3.50 each semester of study**.
- Awarded students must comply with the <u>Student Scholarship Terms and Conditions</u> <u>Contract</u> of the Foundation in order to continue to receive the award for each semester.
- The Gifted Tuition Scholarship cannot be used for online classes.
- All applicants must complete the Gifted Scholarship Applications on the LGCF website before the deadline.

## 3. Tuition Assistance Scholarship

- The Tuition Assistance Scholarships will be awarded to aspiring talented music students, with interest in Latin music, with financial limitations pursuing, starting, or continuing a degree in music at the college or university of their choice. This is a one-time award that will cover totally or partially the tuition amount not covered by other scholarships.
- The recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee from an international pool of candidates.
- The Tuition Assistance Scholarships will support several students per year.
- The college or university in which the student is enrolled will receive **up to US \$10,000**, payable by semester, **for tuition costs only**, towards his/her music training and college education. This award will only cover tuitions costs and will only be valid for one year of study for the following semesters: **Fall 2025** and **Spring 2026**. Additionally, the students will receive wrap around services from the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation valued at **\$2,500** during their studies.
- All scholarship recipients must honor and maintain standards of excellence that will be assessed every semester and maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of **3.00 each semester of study.**
- Awarded students must comply with the <u>Student Scholarship Terms and Conditions</u> <u>Contract</u> of the Foundation.
- The Tuition Assistance Scholarship cannot be used for online classes.
- All applicants must complete the Tuition Assistance Scholarships Application on the LGCF website before the deadline.

#### 4. Gibson Gives Tuition Assistance Scholarship

- The Gibson Gives Tuition Assistance Scholarships will be awarded to aspiring talented music students, with an interest in Latin music with acoustic or electric guitar as their principal instrument, with financial limitations pursuing a degree in music at the college or university of their choice. This is a one-time award that will cover totally or partially the tuition amount not covered by other scholarships.
- The recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee from an international pool of candidates, and each recipient will receive a Gibson guitar.
- The Gibson Gives Tuition Assistance Scholarships will support up to **three (3)** students per year.
- The college or university in which the student is enrolled will receive **up to US \$10,000**, payable by semester, **for tuition costs only**, towards his/her music training and college education. This award will only cover tuitions costs and will only be valid for one year of study for the following semesters: **Fall 2025** and **Spring 2026**. Additionally, the students will receive wrap around services from the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation valued at **\$2,500** during their studies and a Gibson guitar.
- All scholarship recipients must honor and maintain standards of excellence that will be assessed every semester and maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of **3.00 each semester of study.**
- Awarded students must comply with the <u>Student Scholarship Terms and Conditions</u> <u>Contract</u> of the Foundation.
- The Gibson Gives Tuition Assistance Scholarship cannot be used for online classes.
- All applicants must complete the Tuition Assistance Scholarships Application on the LGCF website before the deadline.

- Applicants who are interested in applying for multiple 2025 Scholarships, must complete separate applications for each scholarship.
- All interested students must complete the application process by the deadline of <u>April 10<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>2025, at 11:59pm ET</u>. Applications that are late, incomplete, or not within the guidelines will not be reviewed.
- The scholarship selection and award process will be guided by a Scholarship Committee formed by Latin music experts elected by the LGCF.
- Each applicant must submit YouTube links of two (2) video auditions playing two (2) pieces of Latin music genres as a soloist, with an accompanist or a small ensemble.
  - i The first piece performed should be in a medium tempo and the second piece in a fast tempo. If you can, improvise a minimum of two choruses. Improvisation is not a requisite, but it is welcomed.
  - ii The two required pieces should not last more than 15 minutes. Original compositions can be included as a third optional piece.
  - iii All applicants must <u>clearly identify themselves</u> in all recordings so that the Scholarship Committee can fairly identify the applicant and evaluate each performance.
- Each applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from the applicant's music teachers or music instructors describing the applicant's academic and musical performance levels.
- Payments of Scholarship Awards will be made by the Foundation directly to the music institution on behalf of the scholarship recipient and will be made on a semester basis. Awarded students must send to the LGCF their official student invoices and payment calendars of their music institutions upon receiving notification of the scholarship.
- If the applicants have been also awarded scholarships by their music institution or other organizations, they must upload their awarded scholarship letters to the LGCF application.
- The LGCF reserves the right to ask the applicant for additional information.
- The LGCF does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, religion, national origin, disability, or age.
- All LGCF scholarships must be used within a maximum of 6 months of being awarded (start on Fall 2025 or no later than Spring 2026).
- Please note that all applicants who receive awards from LGCF must comply with our <u>Student</u> <u>Scholarship Terms and Conditions Contract</u> below.

## **Student Scholarship Terms and Conditions Contract**

- 1. The scholarship awarded amount will be paid to the music education institution, on a semester basis, on behalf of the awarded student.
- 2. The awarded students will become Scholarship Ambassadors of the LGCF and will be joining in promoting its mission, service to communities, and furthering its good works.
- 3. The scholarship recipients may be invited by the LGCF to participate in performances involving other scholarship recipients. They may also be invited to participate in special events and press conferences intended to publicize the scholarship program of the LGCF and the achievements of the recipients.
- 4. All awarded students must send to the LGCF their grades at the end of each semester of study. We also require at the end of each semester a letter of recommendation from the students' private instructor or ensemble professor and a description of the activities in which the student was involved in at the music institution and/or with the LGCF. <u>All of this information must be submitted at the end of each semester</u>. If all of these requirements are met, the student may continue to receive his or her scholarship for the following semesters or can re-apply.
- 5. Students awarded the Warner Music Latina Scholarship, or any of the Gifted Tuition Scholarships must be enrolled in full-time study with a minimum of 16 credits each semester for 8 consecutive semesters (4 years of study).
- Students awarded the Warner Music Latina Scholarship, or any of the Gifted Tuition Scholarships must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.50 per semester. Students awarded the Tuition Assistance Scholarship and Gibson Gives Tuition Assistance Scholarship must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00 per semester.
- 7. Recipients must **NOT** be in disciplinary probation, academic probation or receive D or F grades at any time with the music institution that the scholarship was granted. <u>If this happens</u>, <u>the scholarship will be forfeited and cannot be recouped</u>.
- 8. The scholarship awarded will be used in the principal instrument that the student auditioned for, unless a change of principal instrument is recommended by his or her private instruction professor, the Department Dean or Director, and is approved by the LGCF.
- 9. Recipients must enroll in an institutional group or ensemble that incorporates Latin music <u>each year</u> of his/her studies.
- 10. If a recipient is given an award other than one by the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation<sup>®</sup> Scholarship, he/she must inform the LGCF of that award in writing.
- 11. If during his/her studies the scholarship recipient funded by the LGCF receives a proposal of sponsorship by a commercial brand, or other sponsorships, <u>the recipient must submit the proposal to the LGCF for approval</u>.
- 12. Upon notification of the scholarship, all awarded students will receive via email a W-8BEN tax form if they reside outside the United States or a W-9 tax form if they reside in the United States. All completed tax documents must be returned via email to the LGCF. If the LGCF does not receive the tax document from the student, the scholarship will be rescinded.

- 13. All awarded students must send the LGCF an official tuition invoice from the music institution, an official payment calendar with the payment due dates, and a W-8BEN E tax form if the music institution is outside the United States or a W-9 tax form if the music institution is in the United States.
- 14. All LGCF scholarships are NOT transferable and must be used at the music institution or university to which it was awarded.

By signing the *Student Scholarship Terms and Conditions Contract*, the student accepts the scholarship awarded by the Latin GRAMMY Cultural Foundation<sup>®</sup> and agrees to all the terms and conditions in this document.
