



## SABRINA CARPENTER TO PERFORM AT THE 2026 GRAMMY AWARDS® ON SUNDAY, FEB. 1

### WHO:

Grammy Award® winner and current Grammy® nominee Sabrina Carpenter will perform at the 2026 Grammy Awards®. The two-time Grammy winner is up for six Grammy Awards this year: Record Of The Year ("Manchild"), Album Of The Year (*Man's Best Friend*), Song Of The Year ("Manchild"), Best Pop Solo Performance ("Manchild"), Best Pop Vocal Album (*Man's Best Friend*), and Best Music Video ("Manchild").

Additional performers will be announced in the coming days.

### WHAT:

The 2026 Grammy Awards will be broadcast live on the CBS Television Network and will be available to stream live and on-demand on Paramount+\* (*live and on demand for Paramount+ Premium subscribers, or on demand for Paramount+ Essential subscribers the day after the special airs*)\*

The Grammy Awards are the only peer-recognized accolade in music and are voted on by the Recording Academy®'s voting membership body of music makers who represent all genres and creative disciplines, including recording artists, songwriters, producers, mixers, and engineers.
